

as favoring the proposition for the formation of a rural high school district and the issuance of \$25,000.00 in bonds for the construction of a rural high school building at Eudora, and two (2) votes were recorded as opposing the proposition as outlined above. Total number of votes cast within the territory of the proposed district outside of the corporate limits of the city of Eudora (and all embraced within Eudora township, Douglas county, Kansas) 173, of which total number 152 votes were recorded as favoring the proposition for the formation of a rural high school district and the issuance of \$25,000.00 in bonds for the construction of a rural high school building at Eudora, and 21 votes were recorded as opposing the proposition outlined above. In the entire district embraced within the proposed high school district, corporate city of Eudora and adjacent territory included, a total of 331 votes were cast, of which total number 308 votes "yes" on the proposition for the formation of a rural high school district and the issuance of \$25,000.00 in bonds for the construction of a rural high school building at Eudora, Douglas county, Kansas, and 23 voted "no" on the proposition as outlined above. The board approved the return of the special election as certified by the judges & clerk of said election, the clerk was directed to forward to the clerk superintendent a certified copy of the minutes of this meeting.
