

Monday, November 5, 1917-

The board of County Commissioners met in regular monthly session, with all members present and Commissioner the Chairman J. L. Horner presiding.

The resignation of Mr. H. E. Downs as Clerk of Palmyra township, Douglas County, Kansas was received by the board & accepted, to take effect from and after this date. To fill the vacancy thus occasioned, the board appointed Mr. L. E. Horner, of Kansas, to fill the unexpired term, & directed that the Clerk of the board officially notify Mr. Horner of his appointment, which shall date from & after the filing of his acceptance of his bond.

Tuesday, November 6, 1917-

The board met in regular session, all members present, Commissioner J. L. Horner presiding.

The board ordered the cancellation of the \$1.00 dog tax assessed against Mr. J. A. Miller of Marion township, and directed the clerk of the board to issue an order to the County Treasurer to this effect.
