In presenting the above resolution Commissioner Green spoke of the necessity of united action in the matter and ~~the~~ ^{more} ~~the~~ ^{adoption} of the resolution. Commissioner Andrews seconded the motion and spoke in similar strain to that of Commissioner Green. The resolution having been discussed, Chairman Hoover called for a vote on the adoption or rejection of the motion, which resulted as follows: Commissioner Andrews, yes; Commissioner Green, yes; but any vote having been recorded as opposing the adoption of the motion, Chairman Hoover declared it carried and instructed the clerk of the board to send a certified copy of the resolution to the Commissioners of the city of Lawrence.
