The following opinion, rendered by County Attorney J. B. Wilson, was read, ordered placed upon the minutes, + filed for future reference:

The Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas:

Gentlemen: Regarding the claim of the Vinland Stage Fair against Douglas County for one-half of premiums paid, as provided in Chapter 189, S.L. of 1917, they have to advise that in conference with Mr. W. H. Hoskinson, Mr. Homer Hoskinson, Mr. Stein + also Mr. Lander of the Fair Association

I carefully examined the items of the claim of the Fair Association in accordance with the letter of opinion of the City Auditor, dated Dec 26, 1917, + applying the law as I find it in that opinion, I find that the following items must be struck from this list of premiums paid as claims in the last half year filed by said Fair Association. The list follows: W. H. Hoskinson, 1st but cut out by C. R. Barnard premium here \$15.00; N. E. DeLester, 2d but cut by Edwards Lane \$10.; G. S. Harris, 2d but cut by Edwards Lane \$5.; G. G. Shaw, 1st but cut from Fred Wells Station, premium by Fred Wells, \$20; Fred Best, but cut from Fred Wells Station, premium by Fred Wells, \$20; Fred Best, but cut from Hope Binn. Station, premium by Hope Binn. \$15; C. C. Carter, 2d but cut from Hope Binn. premium by Hope Binn. \$10; Fred Best, 3d but cut from Hope Binn. Station premium by Hope Binn. \$5.00. Total \$100. You will observe that the amount of \$50. must be deducted from the claim of the Fair Association, which bears said claim \$127.75, dated 9/19/16. I find. The claim therefore now appears for the sum of \$77.75. All other items of the bill are allowed as the above items on behalf of the donor that the facts clearly appear that these premiums were offered direct to the exhibitors by the donors and the list of exhibitors for these premiums were limited to those having contracts with the stations belonging to the donors, thus showing that the offer of these premiums was not for the general benefit of the stock business in the community and was for the purpose of advertising the stations belonging to the donors.
