Mr. Commissioner: Leavenworth & Douglas Co., Kans.

Report on Endow bridge repair work about April 1.
Gentlemen: I have approved the claim of the Leavenworth Bridge Co. for the sum of \$663.00, being in full of \$1,532.00, less their partial estimate on contract for the repair of the Endow bridge. The original contract price for this structure was \$7,490, but with the estimate the total amount approved by me for payment is \$5,759.41, leaving a balance payable of \$1,732.59. The contractor is now at work driving piles at the south end of the bridge, & with the construction of this truss north & since with pile at each end of the structure the bridge will be completed ready for travel, which will be on or about April 1.
