

Thursday, March 7, 1918.

The Board met in adjourned regular session, all the members being present, the Commissioner & Chairman W. P. Green presiding.

Inspector Early in the morning the Commissioners drove to Endora to inspect the work now being done on the bridge crossing the Kneel River at that point, and to meet the Leavenworth County Commissioners, who were there on a similar mission.

Returning from Endora the Board Board met with the board meeting from Leavenworth County in joint meeting and adopted the following by unanimous vote:

That the suggestion of R. L. McAlpine, bridge Commissioner, it was decided to construct an additional part to the Endora bridge on the north end, "an account of washing away of the bank, since letting of contract, work to be done by Leavenworth Bridge Co., under the supervision of said Commissioner. The price agreed upon is to be cost, plus 20%.
