The following petition was presented to the board: 'We, the undersigned, interested land owners & citizens of Douglas county, hereby petition you, the Commissioners of Douglas county, to view the crossing of a branch situated between the 12. Twp. 15, R. 18, Sec. 18, Twp. 15, R. 19, between Maria & Willow Springs townships, crossed by trail route No. 2 out of Rockville, for the purpose of locating and building a bridge across the said branch, as the same is badly needed to aid the traffic along such road & across such branch, and we petition that the same be given your attention at your earliest moment.' The petition is signed by Emory Sanford & 19 others. Action on this petition was deferred to a later date.
