

Monday, May 6 - 1918-

The board met in regular session for the first day of the May meeting, all members present and Commissioners & Chairman Green presiding.

Accepted Mr. Walter Kennedy appeared before the board and offered a compromise of the amount of actual tax on lots No 134-136 Newton street, Baelwin, Kansas amounting to \$37.07, in lieu of tax & interest & penalty, amounting in the aggregate to \$58.84, which compromise amount was accepted by the board.

Upon order from the State Tax Commission, the board ordered a refund of \$6.75 to Mrs. Paul Litz, erroneously charged against her for the year 1917.

A similar order from the board, for a ^{Cancellation} refund of \$11.57, against the Beta Tau Chapter of the Kappa Sigma fraternity, was also ordered by the board. The clerk being directed to issue an order on the County Treasurer in the amount as stated above & in the cancellation order in favor of the Kappa Sigma fraternity.
