Monday, May 13, 1918-

The Board met in regular adjourned session, all members present, and Commissioners + Chairman W.R. Green presiding.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Andrews, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Hoover, the following resolution was read, and by unanimous vote, adopted:-

Be it resolved by the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session convened, that upon the due legal establishment of a grade on Bridge street, now known as Second Street North, in Lawrence, Kansas, from the north end of the Kaw River bridge to Locust street, by the Mayor and Commissioners of said city, the County of Douglas State of Kansas, does hereby agree to pay all damages accruing to property owners, by reason of the establishment of said grade, up to and including the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or no more.

Be it further resolved, that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this session of the said Board of County Commissioners and that a copy hereof be sent to the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Lawrence.

The vote on adoption - Commissioners Andrews, Commissioner Hoover + Chairman Green. Not any vote having been cast as offering, Chairman then declared the resolution adopted.
