And whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, is desirous of permitting the said company to use the said street railway tracks that are now owned by the city of Lawrence, and the said Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Kansas City, Kaw Valley & Western Railway Company, made an agreement in writing by said parties on the 5th day of April, 1916, the same being recorded in full in the minutes of the said Board of County Commissioners of the said 5th day of April, 1916. Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session convened, that the said proposition of the Kansas Electric Utilities Company, above set out be and the same is hereby accepted, subject, however, to any and all the provisions of the aforesaid contract between the said Board of County Commissioners and the Kansas City, Kaw Valley & Western Railway Company. Be it

Further Resolved, that the attention of the said, The Kansas Electric Utilities Company, is hereby specially directed to said contract between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Kansas City, Kaw Valley & Western Railway Company, and that the said, The Kansas Electric Utilities Company, be and it is hereby notified that in accepting the proposition of the said company, as aforesaid, the said Board of County Commissioners does not in any wise bind itself to perform or permit any act or thing contrary to the provisions of the said contract between the said Board of County Commissioners and the Kansas City, Kaw Valley & Western Railway Company. Be it

Further Resolved, that the Kansas Electric Utilities Company is hereby given until June 1, 1918, to accept in writing the conditions set out in this resolution, and that if the said company so accepts said conditions in said time the agreement formed by the proposition of said company and the above acceptance shall be binding upon the said Douglas County, otherwise shall be null and void and of no force or effect as to said company.
