

Friday, May 24 - 1918.

The board this date continued its sessions as a County Board of Equalization. All members were in attendance & Commissioners & Chairman Green presided.

Complaints were heard from Endora township in Endora City, for the equalization of which see Assessment Rolls.

Saturday, May 25 - 1918.

The board this date resumed its sessions as a County Board of Equalization, with all members present & Commissioners & Chairman Green presiding.

This was the date set aside to hear complaints from Wagon Township, but owing to the fact that the assessment for this taxing district had not been completed & therefore figures for the entire township not obtainable, the hearing was incomplete. For the adjustment of these inequalities brought before the board see Assessment Rolls.

The following communication was received & ordered filed after the minutes of the session:

To the Bd of County Commissioners of Douglas Co, Kansas - Gentlemen: you are hereby notified that the Kansas Electric Utility Company accepts the conditions set out in the resolution adopted by your board on May 15-1918, & agrees that the location of its line upon & across the Kansas River bridges at Lawrence shall be subject to the right of the K. C. H. V. & W. Ry. Co., as set out in the contract between said company & the Bd of Co. Commissioners of Douglas Co, Mo., which contract bears date April 5, 1916. The acceptance is upon the condition that as evidenced by your board granting the Kansas Electric Utility Company, its successors & assigns, the right & privilege of operating its power lines across said Kansas River bridges & upon the tracks constructed by you upon said bridges for the transportation as provided in the proposition & offer of said company dated October 19, 1917 & by so said company, its successors & assigns, shall maintain the same in that condition in the city of Lawrence, Kan. The Kansas Electric Utility Company, by its authorized agent.
