

Monday - June 3 - 1918.

The board met in regular session the first day of the June meeting. All the Commissioners were present & Chairman Green presided.

Claims were presented, audited & allowed, for which an Allowance Record.

A petition, signed by John Family, was presented to the board, asking for a location of a cutaway road, described as follows: Beginning at a point where the south line of Sec. 7, T. 13, R. 21 intersects the Wakeusa river, thence in a southeasterly direction along the north bank of said river to where it intersects with the section line between Sec. 5 and 6, T. 13, R. 21, thence north on said section line, terminating at the public road running east & west on the north line of the south half of section 5 and 6, T. 13, R. 21.

Thereupon, the board appointed the following named persons, W. R. Green, J. L. Hoover, & Allison Andrews, & others, with instruction to meet, in conjunction with the county surveyor, at the place beginning, in Embury Township, on Saturday, the 29th day of June, 1918, & proceed to lay out said road, & to give to the public a hearing.

Tuesday - June 4 - 1918.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present & Commissioners & Chairman Green presiding.

Claims against the county were presented, audited & allowed, for which an Allowance Record.

A petition, signed by R. W. Rye and 79 others, members of the Lake Road Association of Marion Township, Douglas County, Kansas, asking the improvement of the county road at the following places: Bridge near J. A. Phlips, 2 culverts southeast of J. H. Phlips, bridge at H. H. Bole, culvert just west of H. H. Bole, bridge at J. Whelan, culverts at J. L. Hoover, culvert just south of N. H. school house, bridge at D. F. Gammon, two hills along A. A. Wellens farm, culvert culvert at Maylight farm, also one at the M. W. Mettaker farm, one culvert north of Washington Creek Church, culvert culvert just west of Church, also one just north of Lake Farm cemetery, & one road. No action was taken pending investigation of the proposed improvements.
