

Monday - June 10 - 1918.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, ⁴⁴Commissioner and Chairman Green presiding. Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed, for which see Allowance Record.

The county clerk presented to the board an order from the State Tax Commission authorizing the board to convene on Saturday, June 15 - 1918, as a board of equalization to hear complaints from taxpayers from Waukena township tax payers who might feel aggrieved at their tax assessments.

Tuesday, June 11 - 1918.

The board met in adjourned regular session, with all members present, + Commissioner + Chairman Green presiding. Claims against the county were presented, audited + allowed, for which see Allowance Record.

Wednesday, June 12, 1918.

The board met in adjourned ~~session~~ regular session, all members in attendance, + Commissioner + Chairman Green presiding.

The resignation of Dr. John C. Riedolph as County Health Officer was presented, + upon motion of Commissioner Hoover, seconded by Commissioner Andrews, the resignation was accepted, to take effect at midnight of June 20 - 1918.

Claims against the county were presented, audited + allowed, as for Allowance Record.

This day also was the first of the 3-day session during which the board will act as an Equalizing Board to hear complaints from residents of the various taxing districts of the county. On this date no complaints were received, + the board adjourned to meet on the morning, June 13, 1918, at 10:00 o'clock A.M.
