Wednesday July 10 - 1918.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members in attendance, & Commissioner & Chairman Green officiating.

The applications of Dr. H. C. Hopper for the position of County Health Officer, at a compensation of \$75.00 a month & the usual mileage; and that of Dr. J. B. Henry for the same office at \$50.00 per month & mileage at the rate of \$10.00 a mile, or he would be willing to fill the office & County Health Officer & County Physician for \$100.00 a month, were read by the Clerk upon motion of Commissioner Andrews, seconded by Commissioner Hoover, Dr. J. B. Henry was designated as County Health Officer to fill the unexpired term of Dr. J. C. Rudolph, at a salary of \$50.00 a month & 10¢ a mile when traveling on County business.

Commissioner Andrews presented the following resolution, which was read by the Clerk:

Whereas, Nakama Township, Douglas County, in and for the year 1916 made a levy for taxes for said year for the general fund of said township on all taxable property in said township in excess of the legal limit for said levy; and

Whereas, the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Ry. Co. on its property in said township was required to pay the sum of \$44.54 in excess of the amount which said township could by law require said company to pay. And

Whereas, the said company paid said excess amount under protest in due form, and now demands that the same be repaid to it. And therefore, be it
