This being a legal holiday no session of this Board was held this date.

Tuesday, Sept. 3, 1918

The Board met in regular session for the first day of the September meeting. All members present and Commissioner and Chairman W. R. Green presiding.

Claims against the County were presented, audited, and allowed for which see allowance record.

In the matter of the hearing on the road petition of Henri Road and others, a communication from W. G. McAdoo, Director General of railroads, was presented affecting these matters, and upon consideration of this the Board ordered this hearing continued indefinitely. At the same time the Board ordered County Engineer Duffie to make an estimate of the cost of this road, giving the result of his estimate to the County Attorney, in order that the latter may take up the matter with the Director General of railroads.
