Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session convened on this 16th day of October, 1918, that there be and there is hereby by said board offered a reward in the sum of \$200.00 for the discovery, arrest and conviction of the guilty person in case of the theft of any automobile of any kind, design or value, occurring within the limits of said County, said reward to be paid to the person who is the procuring cause of said discovery, arrest and conviction.

Be it further resolved by said Board that this resolution be in full force and effect until repealed by resolution of this Board.

It was moved by Commissioner Hoover, and seconded by Commissioner Andrews, that the resolution just read, appearing above, be adopted, which motion prevailed and no other votes to the contrary.
