Joint Board

Meeting

The board of commissioners of Leavenworth County, together with the county attorney of Leavenworth County and the assistant county engineer of Leavenworth County, the county attorney of Douglas County and the county engineer of Douglas County, were in attendance upon this meeting. The hour of 12 o'clock arriving, the clerk was instructed to bring in and open bids for the proposed reconstruction of the north end of the bridge and dikes across the Kaw river at Endora, pursuant to notice in due form made and published.

On due examination and consideration the said boards of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties find that no bids whatever have been submitted as per said notice given, the offer made by U. H. Young of cost plus a reasonable profit not being considered a bid, within the meaning of the notice as published.

Upon motion of G. W. Roe, Commissioner of Leavenworth County seconded by Commissioner A. Andrews of Douglas County the following resolution was ^{unanimously} adopted by the joint boards of Douglas and Leavenworth Counties, to-wit:

Be it resolved, on this day by said boards in joint session as aforesaid that arrangements with some proper party be made for the construction of said portion of said bridge and dikes at a private letting as prescribed by law, and that the Missouri Valley Bridge Company be and it is hereby requested to submit to said boards a proposition for the accomplishment of the work aforesaid, based upon cost price of material and labor, plus a reasonable per cent for management and superintendence; that upon the submission of such a proposition by said company the same be passed upon by each of said boards together with its attorney and engineers, and when found satisfactory to both said boards the same be submitted to the State Highway Commission of the State of Kansas, for its approval before adoption
