

Monday - Dec - 9 - 1918

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, & Commissioner & Chairman W. P. Green presiding.

Claims against the County were presented, audited & allowed, for which see Allowance Record.

Early in the session the board drove to Grant Township & spent the day in going over the proposed hard-surface road known as "Fort to Fort Highway No. 1."

The application of Mrs. Mary Lloyd of 909 Illinois street, Leanne, for admission to Pease Memorial hospital was, upon recommendation of Drs. Henry & Ed. Estabrook, agreed to, her stay at the hospital being conditional upon her physical condition.

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Upon application of P. F. Macker, he filing an affidavit, the board cancelled an item of \$1,000 appearing against him on the tax rolls for the current year, on a statement that the amount stated, \$1,000, was invested in Liberty Bonds for the U.S. government, the tax \$20.70, to be struck off. The clerk was directed to issue a cancellation order on the treasurer for the amount.

The board again drove to Grant Township & spent the rest of the day in going over the proposed hard-surface road, known as "Fort to Fort Highway No. 1."

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
