Tax Payers.

The board authorized the cancellation of \$2,750 personal property valuation, the tax therefor amounting to \$56.92, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that the money was invested in non-taxable bonds (A, J + S. F. P. B. C.)

Conceded Tax

After investigation, the board authorized the cancellation of personal property valuation to the amount of \$4,670, assessed against & appearing on the tax rolls in the name of Vera B. Enslow, administratrix, the tax therefor amounting to \$43.33, it being disclosed that only \$45 remaining in the hands of the administratrix.

The board also authorized the cancellation of personal property valuation to the amount of \$70, against Vera B. Enslow, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that Mrs. Enslow had not been allowed the lawful \$200 exemption allowed to the heads of all families.
