

Tuesday, January 7, 1919.

The board met in a formal regular session with all members present, & Commissioner & Chairman T. P. Green presiding.

The annual report of A. F. Deer, Endora township trustee, & J. E. Miller, Endora township treasurer, was presented to the board & after comparing & checking over the reports, both received the approval of the board.

The quarterly report of Estella Northrup, Register of deeds, was presented to the board showing a total of \$500.00 collected during the quarter. The report was checked over & approved.

The quarterly report of Lewis E. Moore, clerk of the court, for the quarter ending Dec. 31, 1918, was filed with the board, showing a total of \$137.00 collected & \$243.25 charges. Report approved.

The quarterly report of Penelope Jones by the clerk of Court, made to the Auditor of State, showing a total of \$10.00 collected, was filed with the clerk.

The monthly report of H. C. O'Ryan, Superintendent of the County Home & Farm, & of Mrs. McLaughlin, Commissioner of the Poor, of the inmates of the Home during the month of December, 1918, were read & approved.

Claims against the County were presented, audited & allowed - for which see January Allowance Record.

Cancellation of county warrants, aggregating \$60.00, authorized by reason of having been issued three years or longer, was authorized by the board.

Wednesday, January 8, 1919.

The board met in a formal regular session, Commissioner Hoover & Deer present, Commissioner Andrews being in Dakota. Chairman Green presiding.

The board ordered a cancellation of personal property valuation to an amount of \$100.00, appearing against R. C. Moore, on which the tax was \$2.07, the same being situated in Liberty bonds.

The board also ordered a cancellation of personal property valuation to an amount of \$1255.00, appearing against Mrs. L. J. Burns, the tax thereon amounting to \$25.97, it being found to the satisfaction of the board that it was an error in assessment.
