The clerk was directed to issue a cancellation order on the treasurer for that amount.

The board met in adjourned regular session, all the members in attendance, but Commissioner and Chairman P. P. Queen presiding.

Board The bond of R. M. Gray, deputy clerk of Leamington Township, was approved by the board.

Secretary The quarterly report of Geo. C. Prune, County Clerk, of fees collected for the first quarter of 1918, showing \$393.25 collected, was approved by the board.

Secretary The quarterly report of J. R. Woodward, Sheriff, of fees collected and collected for the first quarter of 1918, showing \$444.80 collected and \$265.92 uncollected, was approved by the board.

Committee The annual report of Wm. Mesenhimer, Commissioner of the Poor, showing a total expenditure during the year of \$1,894.25, was filed with the board and by them approved.

Appropriation A motion by Commissioner Andrews, that this Board appropriate \$100.00 for month for the maintenance of the Douglas County Farm Bureau, such appropriation to continue until this Board Douglas Co. has knowledge that the present legislature has changed the law, whereby Farm provision is made enabling the board of County Commissioners of this County to make a levy for the support of the said Bureau; provided,
