

Monday - February 3 - 1919 -

The board met in regular session for the first day of the February meeting. All members were present and Commissioner & Chairman H. P. Green presided.

Quarterly Report The belated quarterly report of J. R. Woodward, sheriff, for the quarter ending September 30, 1918, showing a total of fees collected amounting to \$1,251.14, & fees uncollected \$1,545.57, was read and approved.

Quarterly Report The belated quarterly report of C. E. Lindley, probate judge, for the quarter ending Dec. 31 - 1918, showing a total of fees collected amounting to \$399.15, & fees uncollected \$197.65, was read and approved.

Appointment The application of E. N. Taylor for appointment as Douglas County Aid at Gos Well Puffer, accompanied by a recommendation signed by three residents of Polkville township, was read, and upon motion of Commissioner Andrews, seconded by Commissioner Brown, the appointment of E. N. Taylor as Douglas County Aid at Gos Well Puffer was made, all members voting in the affirmative and not one voting in the negative.

Claims Claims against the county were presented, audited, & allowed, for which see February Allowance Record.

Tuesday, February 4 - 1919 -

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, & Commissioner & Chairman H. P. Green presiding.

Resignation The resignation of Chas. A. Thomas, newly-elected & qualified clerk of Willow Springs township, was read & upon motion, accepted, to take effect immediately. A successor was not named.

Tax Cancellation The board authorized a cancellation of tax amounting to \$16.31, on a personal property valuation of \$865 against H. B. Mitchell, et al of Lawrence, account double assessment. The board also authorized a cancellation of tax amounting to \$2.07, on a personal property valuation of \$100, et al of Lawrence, account not being allowed the constitutional exemption of \$200.
