

The board authorized the cancellation of personal property assessment against C. H. Brown of Lawrence, the property being an unspayed female dog, the tax thereon amounting to \$2.00, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that while he was assessed as having 2 unspayed female dogs, he in fact had but one.

The board likewise authorized a cancellation of personal property valuation of \$15.00 on which the tax amounted to \$3.18, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that she had not been allowed the constitutional exemption of \$20.00, to which she was entitled.

The board also authorized the cancellation of personal property assessment amounting to \$30. the property of Mrs. Minnie Ruby Baldwin, Kansas on which the tax amounts to \$4.00, with 34 added for penalty, it being shown to the satisfaction of the board that she had not been allowed the constitutional exemption of \$20.00, to which she was entitled.
