 The contract for the Missouri Valley Bridge & Iron Co.,
 for repair work on the Eastern bridge, was received from
 the Linnemore Board of County Commissioners, but
 owing to objection on some particular by members of the
 Douglas County board, was not accepted, & the County
 attorney was instructed to return the same to the
 Linnemore County Board, indicating what portions of
 the contract were objectionable, & suggesting changes
 in carrying out the order from the State Tax Com-
 missioner. The board directed a cancellation of the personal
 property assessment of Caroline Coghill, totalling \$20.10,
 the tax on which amounted to \$41.60, it having been deter-
 mined that this property was not taxable in Kansas.
 The clerk was instructed to issue a cancelling order on the
 county treasurer for the amount of tax.

 Road Re-
 titution

The road petition of J. D. Harris & 12 others, asking for the relocation of a road
 beginning at the south of the Wakarusa near the Dickinson bridge, thence running in a northerly
 direction along the south bank of the Wakarusa river, & terminating at a point on the river line between Sec-
 12 & 19, T. 13. N. R. 20, was presented to the board, who designated March 26, 1919, as a day to hear & pass
 H. P. Green, J. D. Harris & the L. D. Harris & others.
