

Tuesday, March 4 - 1919 -

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present + Commissioner + Chairman H. R. Dean presiding.

The auditor reported that he had rejected the bills of Charles M. Albright, amounting to \$5,125.⁰⁰, representing the apparent value of 31 head of cattle condemned by the State Sanitary Live Stock Commission because of tuberculosis. The board sustained the action of the auditor.

Claims against the county were presented, audited + allowed, for which see March Allowance Record.

Wednesday, March 5 - 1919 -

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present + Commissioner + Chairman H. R. Dean presiding.

The depository bond of the Merchants Loan + Savings bank, in amount \$10,000.⁰⁰, was offered + approved by the board.

The minutes of the board meetings for January and February - 1919, were read + approved.

The matter of designating the official County printer for 1919 was taken up. Only one bid was received, that of the Lawrence Democrat, which offered to do the printing at 20¢ an inch. Action was deferred until a later day during the present session.

The board agreed to accept \$90.⁰⁰ as compromise in full payment of taxes for the years 1900, 1902, 1903 on Lot 165 Corn street, Lawrence, the property of E. W. Phillips.
