

Wednesday, March 19-1919

The board met in ~~the~~ regular session, all members present, + Commissioners + Chairman W. R. Green presiding.

In carrying out the order of the State Tax Commission, the board directed to issue to C. G. Markham a refunding warrant for \$9.60 for the one-half the ~~tax~~ tax on lot 31, Sixth street, Rockton, + to cancel the remaining one-half of the tax, amounting to \$9.60. The clerk was directed to issue a refunding warrant for \$9.60 + to issue a cancellation warrant on the County Treasurer for \$9.60.

The board also authorized the cancellation of personal property valuation of \$200.00, the tax on which amounted to \$4.14, against Marie Duffer-Hendley, due to error in not allowing her the Constitutional exemption of \$200.00.

Friday, March 28-1919

The board this date drove to Endora township, + viewed the road petitioned for by J. D. Harris + others, + set Saturday, May 10, 1919, as a day for hearing. (See page 328.)

The board approved the bond of D. V. King, appointed clerk of Willow Springs township, vice Chas. A. Stover, with J. L. Gilliland + John Chinn as sureties.

Saturday, April 5-1919

The board met in regular session, Commissioner Andrews being absent owing to an injury, Commissioner + Chairman W. R. Green presided.
