

Monday, April 7-1919.

The board met in regular session for the first day of the April meeting. Present: Commissioners + Chairman W. R. Chen, Commissioner Harrison, Commissioner Andrews was absent owing to injuries.

Claims against the county were presented, audited + allowed, for which an April allowance passed.

A meeting scheduled for this date between the Board and a representative of the Oregon Lumber Co. was postponed. The present owner of the addition known as Fort Fisher Place, an addition to the city of Lawrence, was by mutual agreement, postponed until April 12-1919.

Tuesday, April 8-1919.

The board met in adjourned regular session, Commissioner + Chairman W. R. Chen presided, Commissioner Harrison present, Commissioner Andrews absent owing to injuries.

The board approved the Abstractor's bond of Edward J. Hickey in the sum of \$5,000, the life of the bond covering five (5) years from + after April 7-1919.

The depository bond of the Merchants National bank in the sum of \$30,000, for a period of one year from March 7, 1919, from to the county to guarantee county deposits.

The quarterly report of Estelle Winkler, Auditor of deeds, was read, showing a total collected of \$876.⁴⁰ Report approved.

The quarterly report (Jan-March, 1919) of J. C. Stevenson, County treasurer, was read, showing a total of \$3900 collected. Report approved.

The quarterly report (Jan-March, 1919) of Geo. C. Brown, County Clerk, was read, showing a total of \$9655 collected. Report approved.

The monthly report of Wm. Wanklin, Commissioner of the Poor, was read, showing a total of \$287. Report approved.

The monthly report of J. B. Hany, County Physician, was read + approved.

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
