

Rural High School Petition-
 thence east 2 miles, thence north 1 mile, thence east 2 miles,
 thence south 1 mile, thence east 2 miles, thence south 1 mile,
 thence east 1 mile, thence south 5 miles, thence west 7 miles
 to the point of beginning.

The amount of bonds to be voted for the construction of
 said high school building shall be twenty thousand (\$20,000)
 dollars; said bonds to be of the denomination of from one
 to five hundred dollars each, bearing a rate of interest not ex-
 ceeding six per cent per annum, and payable at a date not
 exceeding fifteen years from the date of their issue.

The said high school building shall be located at S.W.
 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 14, R. 18, in Douglas County,
 Kansas, and shall be located & secured in compliance with
 Chapter 311, of the Session Laws of 1915, as amended by House
 Bill No. 586, of the Session Laws of 1917.

Accompanying this petition we have your honorable body an
 accurate enumeration of the legal electors of the proposed rural
 high school district, taken as verified by an elector of said
 proposed district.

Here follows a list of 199 names of resident petitioners, also,
 accompanying the petition, showing that there were 321 legal electors
 residing within the territory embraced within the proposed high school
 district.

The board carefully scrutinized the petition, and finding
 that it was signed by more than two-fifths of the legal
 voters in said proposed district; that the proposed district
 contained not less than sixteen square miles; that the peti-
 tion specifically stated that the proposed high school building
 be located in the S.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 14, R. 18,
 and the amount in bonds it was proposed to issue, it was there-
 upon agreed and ordered that the prayer of the petitioners be
 granted, and that an election be called and held Tuesday, May
 6, 1917, in the building known as the Farmers' Union Hall, at
 Globe, Marion Township, within the proposed rural high
 school district; that there may be submitted to the legal
 electors of said proposed district the proposition to form a
 rural high school district from the territory designated in the
 petition, that bonds in the amount of \$20,000 be issued, and that the
 proposed high school building be located in the S.W. 1/4 of the
 S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 14, R. 18.
