

Wednesday, April 16-1919-

The board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, & commissioners & Chairman W. B. Green presiding.

Now motions duly ^{seconded} made, and passed the board without division adopted the following:

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that the petition heretofore filed with The County Clerk of said county, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the "Fort to Fort" Highway, described as a road which has not been legally established as a public road as hereinafter set out by description.

Now, therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to Chas. J. Custard, to-wit: Begins at a point on the east line of the E. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 14, Twp. 12 S. of R. 17 E. 45.5 feet south of the northeast corner thereof, on the center line of the Fort to Fort road as located, thence with a width of right of way of 80 feet, 40 feet each side of the following described center line, northwesterly on a curve of 360.76 feet radius, the tangent of which at the beginning bears N. 61 deg. W., 90 feet to the point of tangent, thence by tangent N. 46 deg. 15' W. 350 feet to point of curve of 563.69 feet radius, bearing north and westward 338 feet to a point 625 feet west of East line and 8 feet south of the north line of the quarter section at the east line of the St. Peter's Catholic Church containing 1.25/100 acres. Also, beginning at the N. W. corner of the east half of said quarter section, thence south 25 feet, east 330 feet, north 25 feet, west 330 feet to beginning, - 18/100 acre. be and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway, and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highways and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on the 7th day of May, 1919.
