Upon motion duly ^{seconded and} made, passed the board without division adopted the following:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas, finds that the petition heretofore filed with the County Clerk of said county, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the "Fort to Fort" Highway, describes a road which has not been legally established as a public road and hereinafter set out by description.

Now, therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to George A. Anderson, to wit: Begin on the East line of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 22, Twp. 12 S. R. 18 E. 920 feet north of the southeast corner thereof, thence on the center line of the Fort to Fort road with a width of right of way of sixty feet, 30 feet each side of the center line, N. 47 deg. 0' W. 110.8 feet to point of curve, thence northward with a radius of 3472.6 feet 248.5 feet to point of tangent, thence on tangent N. 42 deg. 58' W. 448.2 feet to point of curve, thence on a curve of 205.48 feet radius west and southward 238.2 feet to point of tangent, thence on tangent S. 70 deg. 37' W. 936.83 feet to point of curve of 1122.91 feet radius south and westward 280 feet to the west line of the quarter section at 814 feet south of the northwest corner thereof, containing 4.48/100 acres, he and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on the 7th day of May, 1919.
