Now, therefore, it is hereby by said board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to Henry G. Bahnmair, to-wit: Begin at a point on the east line of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Twp. 12 S. R. 18 E. 814 feet south of the northeast corner thereof, at the center line of the Fort to Fort road and on a curve of 1122.81 feet radius, the back tangent of which at this point bears S. 84 deg. 59' W., thence on said curve bearing west and north ward on the center line of the road with a width of right of way of sixty feet, 30 feet each side center line, 769 feet to point of tangent, thence on tangent N. 55 deg. 48' W. 274.32 feet to point of curve of 1521.81 feet radius to west and south ward 665.61 feet to point of tangent, thence on tangent N. 79 deg. 48' W. 1189 feet to the west line of the quarter section at 25 feet south of the northwest corner thereof, containing 3.99/100 acres. The same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway, and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of the said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 O'clock a.m. on the 7th day of May, 1917.
