 he and the same is hereby condemned, taken and
 appropriated for road purposes to be used with
 and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway
 and improved therewith according to the terms of
 the petition asking for the improvement of said high-
 way, and that the same shall be viewed at the
 location thereof at 10:00 O'clock a. m. on the 7th day
 of May, 1919.

Upon motion duly made, ^{recorded} and passed the board
 without division adopted the following:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas
 county, Kansas, finds that the petition heretofore filed
 with the County Clerk of said county, and approved
 by said board, asking for the improvement of a
 highway known as the "Fort to Fort Highway," de-
 scribed a route containing certain sharp turns and
 dangerous places which may be obviated by the ap-
 propriation of the following described land for road
 purposes, and laying out a road on said land.

Now therefore, it is hereby by said Board of
 County Commissioners ordered that the following
 described land, belonging to the M. D. L. Warner estate,
 to-wit: Begin at a point N. 58 deg. 45' W. 45 feet distant
 from the southeast corner of Section 13, Twp. 12 S. of
 R. 17 E., thence N. 58 deg. 45' W. 380 feet to south
 line of the Lawrence and Topeka road, thence S 71 deg.
 E. along the said south line 345 feet, thence south 80
 feet to the beginning, containing 223/1000 acre, he
 and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropri-
 ated for road purposes to be used and made a part of
 the said Fort to Fort and improved therewith according
 to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement
 of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed
 at the location thereof, at 10:00 O'clock a. m. on the
 7th day of May, 1919.
