Upon motion duly made, <sup>seconded</sup> and passed the board without division adopted the following:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas county, Kansas, finds that the petition heretofore filed with the County Clerk of said county, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the "Fort to Fort Highway" specifies certain type or types of road which require additional right of way as hereinafter described.

Now, therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to the United Brethren in Christ Church, To wit: Begin at a point on the west line of the N. W. 1/4 of N. W. 1/4 of Section 14, in Twp. 12 S. of R. 17 E. 33 feet north of the center line of the Fort to Fort Highway located, thence south 4 feet to the north line of the Lawrence and Topeka road, thence east on said north line 25 feet, thence northwesterly 26 feet to beginning - 50 square feet, - and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 O'clock a.m. on the 7th day of May, 1919.
