Upon motion duly ^{recorded} made and passed the board without division adopted the following:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that the petition heretofore filed with the County Clerk of said county, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the Fort to Fort highway, describes a route containing certain sharp turns and dangerous places which may be obviated by the appropriation of the following described land for road purposes, and laying out a road on said land.

Now Therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to George L. McCarty and Minnie Novak, to-wit: Begin 110.2 feet east of the southwest corner of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 22, Twp 12 S., R. 18 E., thence on the center line of the Fort to Fort road with a width of sixty feet, 30 feet on each side of said center line, on a curve of 304 feet radius to the west and northwest 223 feet to tangent point, thence on tangent 121.8 feet to the west line of the quarter section at 920 feet north of the southwest corner, containing 1.28/100 acres, be and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 O'clock a.m. on the 7th day of May, 1919.
