In reference to the above petition the board adopted the following preamble and resolution:

Whereas, There has been presented to the Mayor and Commissioners of The City of Lawrence, a copy of a Petition to the board of county commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, asking said board of said County Commissioners, to vacate and cancel two plats now of record in The office of The Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, of "Fort Thacher" Place, filed respectively on March 1st, 1910 and November 11th, 1911, and now of record in Plat Book No. Three, Pages 28 and 24 records of Douglas County, Kansas, and

Whereas, The City of Lawrence, Kansas, joined in the prayer of the petition above referred to and requested the County Commissioners to grant the
