

Fort & Fort relief prayed for, passed the same by The Mayor and
 Tracher Commissioners on the 24th day of February A. D. 1917,

Whereas, a legal notice of the hearing of the same was published in the daily Gazette, as required by law, said notice stating that said petition would be before the County Commissioners for action at their regular meeting April 7th 1917, and

Whereas, said petition came before said County Commissioners for action at their regular meeting April 7th 1917, but said County Commissioners duly continued said hearing from time to time and finally, until the 19th day of April A. D. 1917, when the same came up for hearing before said County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the full board being present and regularly in session, and

Whereas, on last said date said petitioners appearing by their attorney W. E. Emick, and the said Commissioners appearing in person and by J. B. Wilson, County Attorney, the petitioners have presented their petition and the evidence thereunder and rested, and the said County Commissioners being fully advised in the premises and having duly considered the same unanimously ordered, adjudged and decreed that said petition be allowed, and that the two said plats be declared vacated and cancelled and that they be amended by a corrected plat filed March 14th 1917.

After the reading of the above and its submission to the board for a vote on its adoption or rejection and the announcement that the vote on adoption was unanimous, Chairman Green declared its adoption.

The road petition of Joseph Hoover and thirteen others asking for the relocation of a road described as follows: Beginning at the quarter section corner on the south line of section number 31, in township number 13, south of Range number 18, east. Thence north on the quarter section line in section 31, one mile to the quarter section corner on the north line of said section so that the new location of said road will conform to the road as open and travelled between the fences on the east and west side thereof and terminating as above shown.
