The read petition of Joseph Hoover, and thirteen others, asking for the relocation of a road in Clinton Twp. Douglas County, described as follows: Beginning at the quarter section corner on the south line of section No. 31 in Twp. No. 13 south of range No. 19, East, thence north on the quarter section line, in section 31, one mile, to the quarter section corner on the north line, of said section, so that the new location of said road will conform to the road as open and traveled between the fences on the east and west sides thereof, and terminating as above shown.

Hoover, and Allison Andrews as such viewers, who together with the county surveyor, are directed to meet at the point of beginning in Clinton township, on the 15th day of May, 1919, and make the view.
