Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the construction of concrete bridge work in Grant Township, Douglas County, State of Kansas, said bridge^{work} is located on the road known as the Fort to Fort road, Section B, project No. 7, will be received at the office of the County Clerk at Lawrence, Kansas, until 11 o'clock A.M., May 23, 1919, and then publicly opened.
