Advertisement for Road Construction

1. Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the construction of Federal Aid road work in Douglas County, State of Kansas, said road work known as the Fort to Fort road, Section I, project No. 7, will be received at the office of the County Clerk at Lawrence, Kansas, until 11 o'clock A.M., May 23, 1919, and then publicly opened.

2. The proposed work is located on the public highway in the county before mentioned. Said proposed improvement includes the construction of an Eighteen feet wide Portland Cement Concrete road with 5 feet wide earth shoulders, together with all work involved and indicated by the plans and specifications herewith, beginning at and extending in a westerly direction for a gross distance of 26708.2 feet of which 26736 feet are to be improved. The point of beginning is approximately 5 miles by road from the A. T. & S. F. railroad passenger depot at LeCompton, Kansas. Station No. 760 is approximately 3 miles from the railroad siding at Grover, Kansas.

3. Detailed information of the work to be done may be had by an examination of the plans and specifications on file in the office of the County Clerk.
