Davis, to wit: Begin on the east line of Section 26 at a point 40 feet north of the center line of the Fort to Fort Highway, thence N. 79 deg. 45' W. 300 feet to a point 75 feet north of the center line of said highway, thence S. 86 deg. 45' W. 400 feet to a point 40 feet north of said center line, thence west 220 feet, thence northwesterly 100 feet to a point 50 feet north of center line of said highway, thence west 230 feet to west line of the 18th section, thence south 10 feet more or less to north line of Road #521, thence east to beginning, containing $\frac{9}{10}$ of an acre, be and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the Fort to Fort Highway and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 o'clock a. m. on the 15th day of May, 1919.
