

Upon motion duly made, seconded and passed the board without division made and adopted the following order:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, finds that the Petition heretofore filed with the County Clerk of said County, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the "Fort to Fort" Highway, describes a road which has not been legally established as a public road as hereinafter set out by description.

Now, therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to Wm. A. Whipple, to-wit: Begin at a point 154 feet south of the northeast corner of said tract 40 feet south of the center line of the Fort to Fort Highway, thence north 74 deg. 50' W. 450 feet to a point 40 feet south of the said center line and 18 feet south of the fence on the south side of the road as now used, thence west 170 feet to west line of Whipple's ground at 40 feet south of center line of Fort to Fort Highway, thence north 18 feet to the fence, thence east along the fence 40.5 feet, thence south 74 deg. 50' E. 165 feet to east line of the quarter section, thence south 80 feet to beginning, containing 603/1000 of an acre, be and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the said Fort to Fort Highway and improved therewith according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be received at the location thereof at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on the 16th day of May, 1919.
