The road petition of R. B. Sanders + 15 others, asking for the
 location of a road described as follows: Begin at the Center of
 Sec. 31, Twp. 13. R. 19, thence east on the South side of quarter section
 line for a distance of 120 rods a width of 40 feet; thence east a distance of
 15 rods a width of 40 feet on the said quarter section line; thence in a north-
 westerly direction a distance of about 25 rods a width of 40 feet to intersect with
 the east line of said section 31 at a point 6 1/2 rods north of the center section
 line, was read + approved. Friday, June 13-1919, was designated as the date on
 which to make the road + John L. Hoover, H. P. Green, + A. Anders, to name
 as viewers. The Co. Surveyor to make survey on date designated.
