

Friday, May 23-1919.

The board met in regular session, all the Commissioners present, & Commissioners & Chairman W. R. Green presiding.

The Board of County Commissioners from Lawrence County was present, & together the two boards took up the matter of the repair of the Eudora bridge.

Commissioner Andrews offered the following resolution.

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that said board enter into contract with the Missouri Valley Bridge & Iron Co. at once to construct repair of the bridge across the Kansas river at Eudora, Kansas, as provided by the plans & specifications drawn by the County Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas, and filed with the Clerk of said County, on the day of May 1919, and approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Kansas on the 13th day of May 1919, said contract to be on the "Cost plus" plan, at the bidding when signed by the members of this board; that the Board of County Commissioners of Lawrence County, Kansas, be and they are hereby invited to join in said contract, but that in case they refuse to do so the same shall be binding nevertheless, be that said expense shall be first paid by this County ^{out of the proceeds} part of Lawrence County be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners of said County for payment.

Commissioner Horner seconded the motion, which was adopted upon a vote being taken, was passed, all the commissioners voting aye and not one voting in the negative.

The hour of 11:00 o'clock having arrived, the board adjourned to the court room, in order that the imminent construction of Douglas county citizens and intended officials from other sections of the state of Kansas & other states, might be started, and after quiet hearing been restored, the Chairman ordered the Clerk to open the bids received for the grading, land opening, surfacing, & bridge construction on the proposed Fort to Fort Highway, Project No. 7, Federal Aid Road District No. 5.

The Clerk read the bids, which by sections, follow, the firm or individual bidding being also indicated.
