Upon proper showing the board authorized a reduction of the personal property valuation of Mrs. Wm. Watts, 946 Corn-
street, from \$810.00 to \$410.00. The board also directed that \$300 in the personal property assessment of Geo. Reynolds be cancelled, at appearing to the satisfaction of the board that this amount was represented in Liberty bonds of the U.S. government.

The board declined to grant a reduction in the personal property valuation of Henry Page.

The board declined to grant a reduction in the A.C. Kirch personal property valuation.

Upon a proper showing that the amount assessed against the real property of Mrs. A. C. Gibson was excessive and not proportionate to the assessment placed upon homes in the immediate neighborhood, the board directed a reduction in her personal property assessment to an amount not greater than \$5,000.00 on real estate & improvements.
