The Board met in adjourned regular session, all members present, and Commissioner & Chairman W. R. Green presiding.

The Board took up the matter of the claims of the various persons from whom land is to be taken for the proposed Fort-to-Fort Highway, project no. 7. made the following orders:

The Board, having under consideration the application of W. O. Whipple for land taken and damages accruing by reason of the proposed construction of the Fort-to-Fort Highway, Project no. 7. Having given the matter full consideration, hereby orders, that the amount determined by said board at the official view of said land, to wit: \$250, be adhered to and the same is hereby officially determined as the amount allowed by said board for the purposes above indicated; and further finds that such portions of the claim of the said W. O. Whipple as is in excess of the said \$250 is hereby disapproved and rejected.

The Board, having under consideration the application of Geo. L. McCarty and Minnie Norac for land taken and damages accruing by reason of the proposed construction of the Fort-to-Fort Highway, Project no. 7. Having given the matter full consideration, hereby orders, that the amount determined by said board at the official view of said land, to wit: \$300, be adhered to and the same is hereby officially determined as the amount allowed by said board for the purposes above indicated; and further finds that such portions of the claim of the said Geo.
