

Wednesday, June 11 - 1919

The board met in adjourned regular session, Commissioners Andrews and Hoover in attendance.

Claims against the county were presented, Audited, and allowed, for which see June Allowance Record.

At the close of the morning session, the board adjourned for the balance of the day, in the afternoon attending the funeral of the late chairman of the board, W. R. Green.

Thursday, June 12 - 1919

Upon telephonic request from the State Sanitary Live Stock Commission, Commissioner Hoover drove out to the Geo. Bahnmaier home, in Secompton Twp., and in company with the deputy Sanitary Live Stock Commissioner, examined a tuberculosis cow, the property of Mr. Bahnmaier, but failed to agree on the amount of damages.

Friday, June 13 - 1919
