The board met in regular session, Commissioners Andrews and Hoover in attendance.

Commissioner Hoover offered the following resolution, which was unanimously adopted.

Resolution of sympathy and condolence on the death of W. R. Green, late Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas.

Recognizing the sterling and stalwart qualities and character of the late W. R. Green, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, his splendid life and example as a citizen of this County, and his long and excellent service as an official, first in the capacity of Commissioner of the Poor, second as County Clerk and third as County Commissioner from the first district, and as Chairman of this Board; and being deeply moved with sorrow because of his sudden death, we, the surviving members of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, hereby tender to the bereaved family on behalf of ourselves, and of the County as a whole, the most sincere sympathy in this, their great loss, and assure them that Douglas County will ever remember with profound pride the most estimable life services of our fellow citizen and co-worker, and of their loved one, the late W. R. Green.

It is by the Board hereby ordered that a copy of this communication be sent to Mrs. W. R. Green, a copy be delivered to the newspapers for publication, and a copy be spread upon the minutes of this Board as of this date.

An understanding was reached between Commissioner Andrews, of the 2^d Commissioner district, & Commissioner Hoover, of the 3^d Commissioner district, whereby Commissioner Andrews assumes the part of Chairman of the Board for the remainder of the year 1919, filling that part of the late W. R. Green's duties to which he was elected January 14 last.
