

Monday - June 30 - 1919.

The board met in regular session, all commissioners present, but Commissioner + Chairman Al. Anderson presiding.

Upon motion duly made, seconded + passed, the board, without division adopted the following order:

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, find that the petition heretofore filed with the County Clerk of said county, and approved by said board, asking for the improvement of a highway known as the Fort to Fort Highway, specific certain type or types of road which require additional right of way, as hereinafter described:

And therefore, it is hereby by said Board of County Commissioners ordered that the following described land, belonging to Florence G. Clarke nee M. Dawson, to-wit: Begin at a point on the east line of the west half of Block 50, in west Lawrence, at ~~the~~ twenty-five (25) feet north of the center line of the Fort to Fort Highway, thence north thirty-seven (37) feet, thence west parallel with the center line of said highway one hundred and sixty-five (165) feet, thence south 78 deg. W. one hundred and seventy-six (176) feet to a point twenty-five (25) feet north of the center line of said highway, thence east three hundred and forty (340) feet to beginning, containing 216/1000 of an acre, be and the same is hereby condemned, taken and appropriated for road purposes to be used with and made a part of the Fort to Fort Highway and improved there-with according to the terms of the petition asking for the improvement of said highway, and that the same shall be viewed at the location thereof at 10:00 o'clock A.M. on the 19th day of July, 1919.

Upon recommendation of Dr. J. B. Henry, County Physician, the board directed that Grant M. Haggerty be treated at the Rensselaer Hospital for 30 days at the expense of the county.

This was the date set for opening of bids for the construction of Sections A, B, E, & F of the Fort to Fort Highway. At the hour of 11:00 having arrived. The board, together with citizens + contractors, repaired to the District Court room, where all could be seated + hear + see. The clerk then opened and read the bids, which by sections follow:
