With the inclusion and adoption of this amendment to the contract, Section 4, Fort to Fort Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 7, the notes of Commission charged by Commission. The Federal Road District No. 5 was awarded to J. C. Patterson & Co. at the contract price of \$206,391.47. Motion carried.

Upon motion of Commissioner Harns, seconded by Commissioner E. C. F. Fort to Fort Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, were rejected, as being excessive in price and far beyond the figure in the estimates furnished by the State Highway Engineer. It was also moved and seconded by the same Commissioner Order Read that Sections E and F, Fort to Fort Highway, Federal Aid Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, be subcontracted for E & F northwork and culvert construction. Motion carried.

By the unanimous vote of the three commissioners, A. C. Lagare, Mr. A. C. Lagarewall of Topeka, Kans., was elected Resident Engineer on the work covered by Project No. 7, Federal Road District No. 5, Fort to Fort Highway, at a salary of \$250.00 per month.
