

Saturday, July 5, 1919.

The board met in regular session, Commissioners Cox and Andrews being present. Chairman Andrews presided.

The following preamble and resolution was offered by Commissioner Cox and adopted:

Whereas, there is a demand for the construction of ^{per-}manent repairs to the present bridge or the construction of a permanent bridge across the Kansas river at Eudora, Kansas. Be it

Resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the Board of County Commissioners of Lawrence County, Kansas, be and it is hereby notified that there will be a meeting of both said boards at the office of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County at the court house in said County at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 12, 1919, for the purpose of doing all things necessary to arrange for the construction of said structure above indicated.

Commissioners Cox and Commissioners Andrews voted aye on the adoption of the resolution, and not one vote being cast against adoption of the resolution, Chairman Andrews declared the motion carried.

Monday, July 7, 1919.

The board met this date for the first day of the July session. All the Commissioners were present, but Commissioner Cox was Chairman A. Andrews presided.

Upon authority from the State Tax Commission, the board ordered cancellation of personal property assessment against J. H. McCoy, in amount \$600.00, representing an authorized charge for a mortgage, which the deputy assessor understood he possessed, but which really was not McCoy owned that sum in the form of a mortgage on his home. The board directed the clerk to draw an order of cancellation limited to the county treasurer for that amount.
